**Summary of unit and Position/s:**

Austin Health is the major provider of tertiary health services, health professional education and research across 3 campuses in the northeast of Melbourne and state-wide. Austin Health is world-renowned for its research and specialist work in cancer, liver transplantation, spinal cord injuries, critical care, neurology, endocrinology, mental health and rehabilitation.

The Austin Intensive Care Unit is a 20-bed unit that admits about 2300 patients annually, with occupancy of about 6500 bed days and 3000 MET calls. The unit is a general adult surgical/medical ICU including cardiac surgery. It is also the state referral centre for spinal cord injuries, liver transplantation and acute liver failure. The ICU runs the medical emergency and cardiac arrest team, and also takes part in the trauma team.

The Austin ICU is accredited by the College of Intensive Care of Australia and New Zealand as a C24 Training Institution.
