Summary of unit and Position/s:

The Respiratory and Sleep Medicine Department provides clinical services to inpatients and outpatients, teaching of undergraduates and postgraduates and is extensively involved in clinical and basic research. There is a busy respiratory laboratory and an eight bed sleep disorders unit. Major interests and research include COPD, Respiratory Physiology, Asthma and Sleep disordered breathing and non-invasive ventilation. There are four Registrar positions and staff rotate through the inpatient respiratory ward, the Victorian Respiratory Support Service and the various laboratories. Each Registrar attends at least one respiratory outpatient session and is responsible for one bronchoscopy session per week. Numerous opportunities are available for research through hospital based and Institute for Breathing and Sleep – based programs.
