

HMO/PGY 3 Surgical – 2011

Thank you for your interest in applying for a position as a Surgical HMO/PGY 3 at Austin Health (AH) and Northern Health (NH). This joint appointment and rostering programme offers you a wide selection of rotations across a major teaching hospital, a large community hospital and associated rural and specialist hospitals. Positions are in medical, surgical and general streams with a variety of rotations available within each group.

HMO3 Surgical positions include a variety of accredited general and specialty surgical rotations, as well as ICU, Emergency Medicine and Night duty. A list of rotations available to all HMO/PGY3 applicants is attached. Candidates who have completed this year have successfully undertaken training in the following areas: GP programs, SET, obstetrics, physician training (general and speciality), ophthalmology, radiology, nuclear medicine, etc. Acceptance into a training program is not a pre-requisite for successful application to this stream, however completion of a satisfactory HMO2 Surgical stream year is a pre-requisite.
